LAB # 9: Episodes 81-85

Scripture Reading: [Ep. 81] John 8:14 and 42, John 16:28, 1 Peter 2:11, Hebrews 11:8-10. [Ep. 82] Ephesians 1:22-23, 1 Samuel 15:1-35 [Ep. 83] Colossians 2:9-10 and 18, Colossians 3:3, Revelation 19:10, Revelation 22:8-9, Hebrews 1:6, John 16: 12-15, 1 Corinthians 15:38-47 [Ep. 84] Acts 8:9-25, Exodus 33:1-3, Acts 19:11-17 [Ep. 85] Mark 11:12-14 and 20-22, John 14:9-12, John 16:12-15.

Prayer Time: Practice praying in the spirit for 25 minutes daily. (This should be time that is set aside in your day and not combined with other activities.) Before you pray, thank the Lord for the day and ask Him to provide you with interpretation of what you're praying. (We are taught in Mark 11:24 that once we ask/pray in faith, we are to have confidence that God has granted our request. It is done.) The Holy Spirit will bring understanding of what you have been praying about in a variety of ways. It can be immediate understanding or come as you go about doing another task during the day, but He will get the information to you.

Prayer Points/Focused Action:

- Continue working on walking with the Lord in absolute obedience to His guidance, daily. This must become a habit instead of an occasional occurrence.
- Continue to use your Life-Span confession that we created in Lab #7 daily.
- When you pray, always pray from a perspective and mindset of faith (trust and confidence) in God – His faithfulness to His word and His ability to carry out what He has committed to do - never fear. **BOLO (Be On the Look Out):** Identify fear masquerading as thoughts: “What if...” “I don’t want *this* to happen so I will...” “God might not... so I better...” “It seems like...” When/if you identify fear masquerading as thoughts, you must deal with it immediately. Submit to God, resist the devil, and do not allow his words of fear. Doubt, or unbelief to take root in your mind. Make a mental note of what is being said. Understand that it is coming from the adversary, and it is an attack against your mind, then open your mouth and speak the word of God. Say, aloud, “In the name of Jesus, I bind (declare illegal) those thoughts and ideas. I bind fear, doubt, unbelief, and the adversary coming against me mind in the almighty name of Jesus. I cast the adversary out, in the name of Jesus. Holy Spirit, I loose (allow You) to speak the truth to me and guide me into all truth and Your perfect will.” Worry and dread are other names for fear as well.

Meditation#1: Read the scriptures below to help you meditate throughout your week to help you better understand the importance of using your faith in God when you pray instead of praying from a mindset of fear or dread.

“There is no fear in love [dread does not exist]. But perfect (complete, full-grown) love drives out fear, because fear involves [the expectation of divine] punishment, so the one who is afraid [of God’s judgment] is not perfected in love [has not grown into a sufficient understanding of God’s love].” **1 John 4:18 AMP**

“Do not fear, little flock, for it is your Father’s good pleasure to give you the kingdom.” **Luke 12:32 NKJV**

“The centurion answered and said, “Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed.” **Matthew 8:8 NKJV**

“And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, “I believed and therefore I spoke,” we also believe and therefore speak” **2 Corinthians 4:13 NKJV**

Again, the devil took Him up on an exceedingly high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory. And he said to Him, "All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me." Then Jesus said to him, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve.'" Then the devil left Him, and behold, angels came and ministered to Him." **Matthew 4:3-11 NKJV**

Question #9: [Two-Part Question] Read the scriptures below to help you answer the question below.

“John said to Him, “Teacher, we saw someone casting out demons in Your name, and we tried to stop him because he was not accompanying us [as Your disciple].” But Jesus said, “Do not stop him; for there is no one who will perform a miracle in My name, and be able soon afterward to speak evil of Me. For he who is not against us is for us.”

Mark 9:38-40 AMP

“Then some of the itinerant Jewish exorcists took it upon themselves to call the name of the Lord Jesus over those who had evil spirits, saying, “We exorcise you by the Jesus whom Paul preaches.” Also there were seven sons of Sceva, a Jewish chief priest, who did so. And the evil spirit answered and said, “Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are you?” Then the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, overpowered them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded. This became known both to all Jews and Greeks dwelling in Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified.”

Key Terms:

Sojourner - A foreigner or stranger who is living in or traveling through a country or place that is not native to them. Believers who are traveling temporarily through the earth have a mission from the Heavenly Father to carry out while temporarily living on the earth.

Chain of Command – The rank and order that power and authority flow within the Kingdom of God. Flows from those with greatest authority to those with least authority.

Top-down – The direction that authority, guidance, orders, and instruction flows within the Kingdom of God. Commands come from the Father to the Son, through the Holy Spirit to believers and the angel army. Believers stand before the Lord and take orders from Him. Holy Spirit conveys what those orders are.

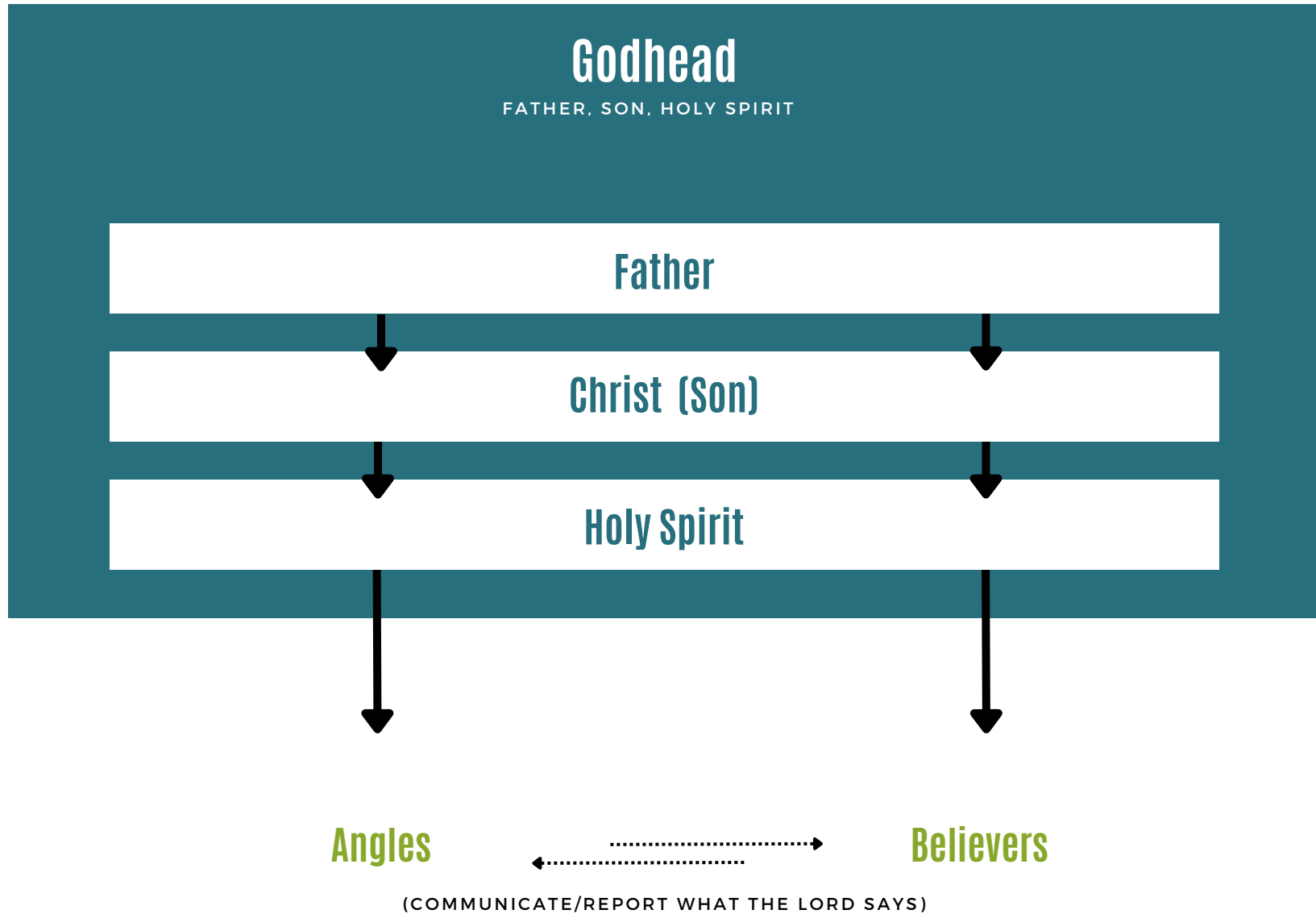
Key Take-A-Ways

1. We (believers) have come from the Father and are foreigners to the earth – we are traveling through the earth. The earth is not our permanent home.
2. Christ is the Head of all things to the Church, His Body, and He is the Commander of the armies of the Lord (angels and believers).
3. The chain of command in the Kingdom flows from the Father down to us. Pass all your plans and opinions before the Last Adam to see what He says about it.
4. Man(kind) was created to be led by the Lord, not to lead himself or be led by anything/anyone else.
5. Obedience to the Chain of Command is vital for God's warriors.
